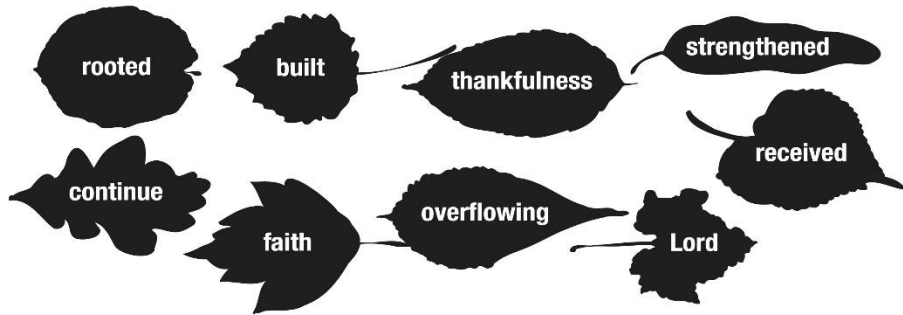




Piles of praise
