The three best things we have are faith, hope, and love. But the absolute most important, THE best, THE greatest is love. It's the best gift we have, and it's the best thing we can do.

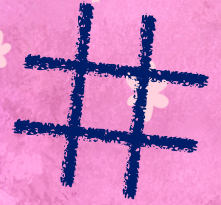
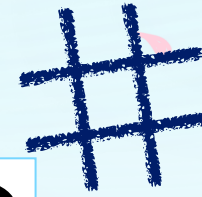
### REMEMBER THIS
